

STAGE	6 – EXEMPT AREAS (A WCP must be prepared and approved by AlburyCity)
Public Awareness Campaign (Voluntary)	<p>Ensure your property has no leaks. Install a trigger nozzle on garden hoses. Ensure that any automatic sprinkler system works correctly, does not leak and that the timer shut off is correctly working. Do not water lawns during the day, (between 10.00 am and 5.00 pm). Do not hose concrete or paved pathways or driveways.</p>
1 (Compulsory)	<p>Ensure your property has no leaks. Install a trigger nozzle on garden hoses. Ensure that any automatic sprinkler system works correctly, does not leak and that the timer shut off is correctly working. Do not water lawns during the day, (between 10.00 am and 5.00 pm). Do not hose concrete or paved pathways or driveways.</p>
2 (Compulsory)	<p>Ensure your property has no leaks. Install a trigger nozzle on garden hoses. 2a (Compulsory)	<p>An exempt area (see Definitions) can only be watered by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • using a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, or a watering can or bucket filled either by hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, or directly from a tap, within the hours of 6.00 am and 10.00 am and 6.00 pm and 10.00 pm (7.00 am and 11.00 am and 4.00 pm and 8.00 pm non daylight saving period) on the designated days (see Definitions for explanation of designated days); or • a manually operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between the hours of 6.00 am and 10.00 am and 6.00 pm and 10.00 pm (7.00 am and 11.00 am and 4.00 pm and 8.00 pm non daylight saving period) on designated days (see Definitions for explanation of designated days); or • an automatically operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between the hours of midnight and 8.00 am on designated days (see Definitions for explanation of designated days).
3 (Compulsory)	<p>An exempt area (see Definitions) can only be watered by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • using a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, or watering can or bucket filled either by a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle or directly from a tap between 6.00 am and 8.00 am and 8.00 pm and 11.00 pm (7.00 am and 9.00 am and 4.00 pm and 7.00 pm non daylight saving period) on designated days (see Definitions for explanation of designated days); or • a manually operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between 6.00 am and 8.00 am and 8.00 pm and 11.00 pm (7.00 am and 9.00 am and 4.00 pm and 7.00 pm non daylight saving period) on designated days (see Definitions for explanation of designated days); or • an automatically operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between midnight and 6.00 am on designated days (see Definitions for explanation of designated days).

<p>3a (Compulsory)</p>	<p>An exempt area (see Definitions) can only be watered by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • using a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, or watering can or bucket filled either by a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle or directly from a tap between 6.00 am and 8.00 am and 8.00 pm and 10.00 pm (<i>7.00 am and 9.00 am and 4.00 pm and 6.00 pm non daylight saving period</i>) on designated days (see definitions for explanation of designated days); or • a manually operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between 6.00 am and 8.00 am and 8.00 pm and 10.00 pm (<i>7.00 am and 9.00 am and 4.00 pm and 6.00 pm non daylight saving period</i>) on designated days (see Definitions for explanation of designated days); or • an automatically operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between midnight and 4.00 am on designated days (see definitions for explanation of designated days).
<p>4 (Compulsory)</p>	<p>An exempt area (see Definitions) can only be watered by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • using a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, or watering can or bucket filled either by a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle or directly from a tap between 6.00 am and 8.00 am (<i>7.00 am and 9.00 am non daylight saving period</i>) on designated days (see definitions for explanation of designated days); or • a manually operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between 6.00 am and 8.00 am (<i>7.00 am and 9.00 am non daylight saving period</i>) on designated days (see Definitions for explanation of designated days); or • an automatically operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between midnight and 4.00 am on designated days (see definitions for explanation of designated days). <p>NOTE: The NSW Government states that Council will be able to water nominated parks and sports fields within their town water supply allocation. Further nominated/designated areas of schools may also be watered.</p> <p>These areas are considered exempt areas; however a fully detailed Water Conservation Plan will be required.</p>
