

Memorandum of Understanding
Between Holy Spirit Primary School in The City of Albury, New South
Wales, Commonwealth of Australia and Shiyan Primary School in the
City of Nanping of the Fujian Province of the People's Republic of
China
To Develop Friendly Exchanges

At the invitation of Nanping Municipal People's Government, The Mayor of Albury City, Cr Patricia Gould, led a government delegation to visit Nanping on July 13-18, 2009, to further develop a friendly relationship between the two primary schools and to enhance understanding, friendship and cooperation between the teachers and students.

An Agreement has been reached to promote friendly consultation with each other, as follows:

1. Local Cultural experiences and exchanges.
2. Mutual sharing of educational experiences and approaches.
3. To use appropriate ways to study each other's languages and literature.
4. Actively work towards hosting teacher and /or student exchanges.
5. To develop friendly relationships between the teachers and students at the two schools involving the exchanges of letters, emails, etc (pen-pal concept).
6. To explore opportunities for visits between the schools, focusing on sporting, cultural and tourism exchanges.
7. Exchange of ideas on local and international environmental issues.

This Memorandum of Understanding has been prepared in both English and Chinese, both texts being equally authentic, 2 completed and signed in duplicate in Nanping City on July 14, 2009.
