1 (Compulsory)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> An existing or new mobile spa with a capacity less than 2000 litres may be filled or topped up by the town water supply by means of either a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, a watering can or by a bucket at anytime. A new mobile spa with a capacity greater than 2000 litres must not be filled by the town water supply. They must be filled with an alternate water source (pool owners and companies must provide evidence that water has been obtained from an alternative source). Once filled a new mobile spa with a capacity greater than 2000 litres is filled by an alternate water source it may be topped up by the town water supply by means of either a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, a watering can or by a bucket at anytime.
2 (Compulsory)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Empty pools or spas with a capacity of less than 2000 litres can be filled with the town water supply but only on alternate days before 10.00am and after 5.00pm. Empty pools or spas with a greater capacity of 2000 litres cannot be filled with the town water supply. They must be filled with an alternate water source, such as bore or dam water. Pools and spas of any capacity that are at least 75% full can be topped up with the town water supply on alternate days before 10.00am and after 5.00pm.
2a (Compulsory)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A mobile spa with a capacity less than 2000 litres, may be filled or topped-up by means of either a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle or a watering can or bucket but only on designated days and within designated times (see Definitions for explanation of designated days). A mobile spa with a capacity greater than 2000 litres must not be filled with the town water supply. They must be filled with an alternate water source, such as bore or dam water. Once filled a new mobile spa with a capacity greater than 2000 litres that is at least 75% full may be topped-up by means of either a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle or a watering can or bucket, but only on designated days and within designated times (see Definitions for explanation of designated days).
3 (Compulsory)	An existing or new mobile spa of any capacity may not be filled or topped up at any time.
3a (Compulsory)	An existing or new mobile spa of any capacity may not be filled or topped up at any time.
4 (Compulsory)	An existing or new mobile spa of any capacity may not be filled or topped up at any time.
