

STAGE	5 - SPORTSGROUND
<p>Public Awareness Campaign (Voluntary)</p>	<p>Ensure your property has no leaks. Do not water lawns and gardens during the day, (between 10.00 am and 5.00 pm). Ensure that any automatic sprinkler system works correctly, does not leak and that the timer shut off is correctly working. Install a trigger nozzle on garden hoses.</p>
<p>1 (Compulsory)</p>	<p>A sportsground can only be watered by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • using a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, or a watering can or bucket filled either by a hand held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, or directly from a tap, at any time before 10.00 am and after 5.00 pm on any day; or • a manually operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between the hours of 6.00 am and 10.00 am and 6.00 pm and 10.00 pm (<i>7.00 am and 11.00 am and 4.00 pm and 8.00 pm non daylight saving period</i>) on any day; or • an automatically operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between the hours of midnight and 8.00 am on any day.
<p>2 (Compulsory)</p>	<p>A sportsground can only be watered by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • using a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, or a watering can or bucket filled either by a hand held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, or directly from a tap, at any time before 10.00 am and after 5.00 pm on alternate days (see Definitions for explanation of alternate days); or • a manually operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between the hours of 6.00 am and 10.00 am and 6.00 pm and 10.00 pm (<i>7.00 am and 11.00 am and 4.00 pm and 8.00 pm non daylight saving period</i>) on alternate days (see Definitions for explanation of alternate days); or • an automatically operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between the hours of midnight and 8.00 am on alternate days (see Definitions for explanation of alternate days).
<p>2a (Compulsory)</p>	<p>A sportsground can only be watered by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • using a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, or a watering can or bucket filled either by hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, or directly from a tap, within the hours of 6.00 am and 10.00 am and 6.00 pm and 10.00 pm on the designated days (see Definitions for explanation of designated days); or • a manually operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between the hours of 6.00 am and 10.00 am and 6.00 pm and 10.00 pm (<i>7.00 am and 11.00 am and 4.00 pm and 8.00 pm non daylight saving period</i>) on designated days (see Definitions for explanation of designated days); or • an automatically operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between the hours of midnight and 8.00 am on designated days (see Definitions for explanation of designated days). <p>Despite the above, a sportsground may be watered in accordance with a Water Conservation Plan (WCP) prepared by the operator and approved by AlburyCity for the purposes of Stage 2a restrictions.</p>

<p>3 (Compulsory)</p>	<p>A sportsground can only be watered by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • using a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, or watering can or bucket filled either by a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle or directly from a tap between 6.00 am and 8.00 am and 8.00 pm and 11.00 pm (<i>7.00 am and 9.00 am and 4.00 pm and 7.00pm non daylight saving period</i>) on designated days (see Definitions for explanation of designated days); or • a manually operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between 6.00 am and 8.00 am and 8.00 pm and 11.00 pm (<i>7.00 am and 9.00 am and 4.00 pm and 7.00pm non daylight saving period</i>) on designated days (see Definitions for explanation of designated days); or • an automatically operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between midnight and 6.00 am on designated days (see Definitions for explanation of designated days) <p>NOTE: On Monday, Thursday and Friday no watering is permitted.</p> <p>Despite the above, a sportsground (exempt or other playing surface) may be watered in accordance with a Water Conservation Plan (WCP) prepared by the operator and approved by AlburyCity for the purposes of Stage 3 restrictions.</p>
<p>3a (Compulsory)</p>	<p>A sportsground can only be watered by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • using a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, or watering can or bucket filled either by a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle or directly from a tap between 6.00 pm and 8.00 pm (<i>4.00 pm and 6.00 pm non daylight saving period</i>) on designated days (see Definitions for explanation of designated days); or • a manually operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between 8.00 pm and midnight (<i>4.00 pm and 8.00 pm non daylight saving period</i>) on designated days (see Definitions for explanation of designated days); or • an automatically operated permanently installed watering system (dripper, sprinkler or microspray) between midnight and 4.00 am on designated days (see Definitions for explanation of designated days). <p>NOTE: On Monday, Thursday and Friday no watering is permitted.</p> <p>Despite the above, an exempt sportsground or other playing surface may be watered in accordance with a Water Conservation Plan (WCP) prepared by the operator and approved by AlburyCity for the purposes of Stage 3a restrictions.</p>
<p>4 (Compulsory)</p>	<p>Sportsgrounds must not be watered at any time.</p>
